

The Saskatchewan Brazilian Jiu Jitsu Federation Inc. Constitution

1. The name of the group is The Saskatchewan Brazilian Jiu Jitsu Federation Inc.
2. The purpose of the group is to organize, regulate, govern, promote and advance Brazilian Jiu Jitsu (BJJ) in Saskatchewan, by:
 - a. Setting standards for BJJ, including for athletes, coaches, clubs, referees and competitions
 - b. setting and enforcing rules of the sport and a code of conduct for members, athletes, coaches, clubs, referees and others
 - c. organizing competitions, setting standards for the organization and conduct of competitions, and licensing competitions and organizers of competitions,
 - d. disciplining members, athletes, coaches, clubs, referees and others,
 - e. representing BJJ to the public, governments, and the media,
 - f. working with other BJJ federations, associations, government, individuals or other governing bodies in Canada,
 - g. purchasing, leasing, selling or holding such property, equipment and materials as are deemed necessary to accomplish the Association purposes, and
 - h. doing all such things as may be incidental and ancillary to the attainment of these purposes.
3. Upon winding up or dissolution of the group, the assets which remain after payment of all cost, charges, and expenses which are properly incurred in the winding up shall be distributed to such charitable organization or organizations having a similar charitable purposes. This provision shall be unalterable.
4. A director must not be remunerated for being or acting as a director, but may be reimbursed for all expenses necessarily and reasonably incurred while engaged in the affairs of the Federation. This provision is unalterable.”
