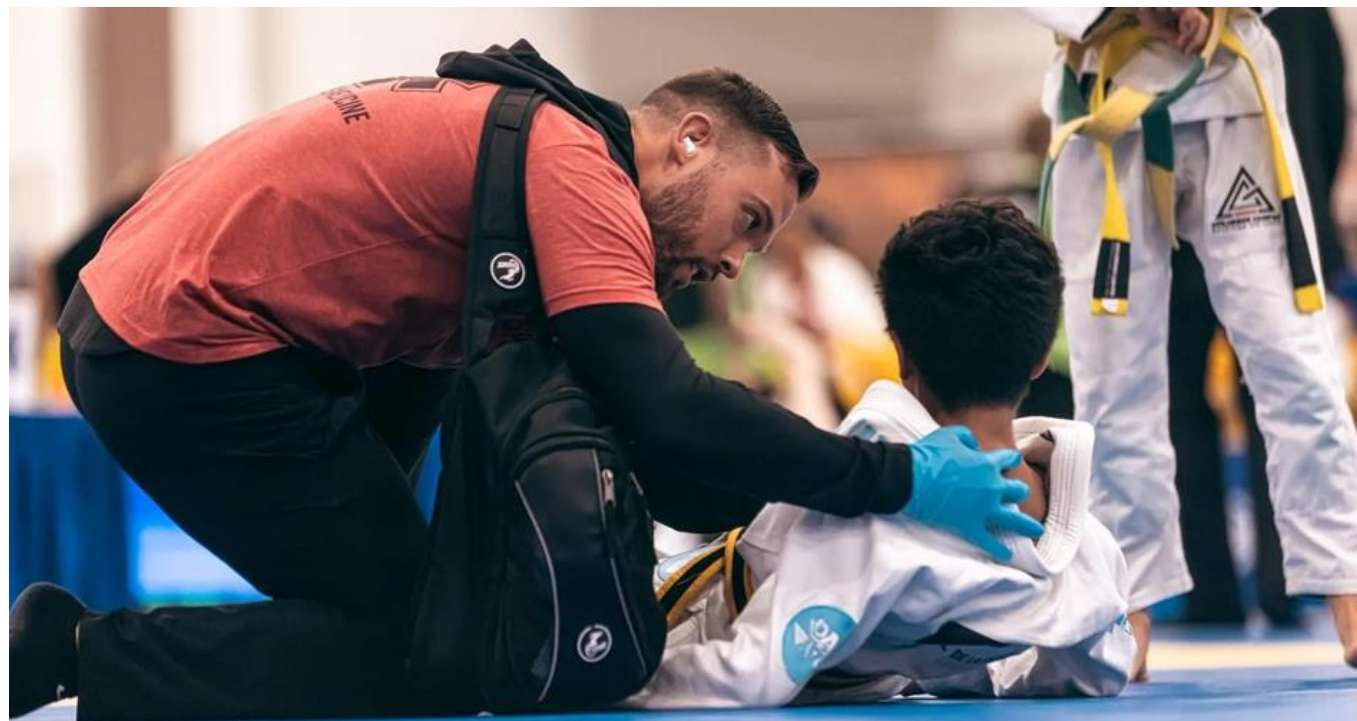


POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

LEVELS OF OFFICIALS



Level 1

Upon Completion of todays course, individuals will be certified level 1 officials automatically.

- Weigh in official
- Gi checker
- Table scorer

Level 2

Officials with a minimum of 5 tournaments experience in Brazilian Jiu Jitsu officiating will be approved certified at level 2 by the CJA (Application form needs to be completed to verify and for records).

Level 3

Level 2 officials should strive toward level 3 status, and this program will be put forward later this year.

POINTS STRUCTURE – BRAZILIAN JIU JITSU

- Takedown – 2 points
- Guard Pass – 3 points
- Knee on belly – 2 points
- Mount – 4 points
- Back Mount – 4 points
- Back Grab – 4 points
- Sweep – 2 points
- Advantages
- Penalties



TAKEDOWN – 2 POINTS





GUARD PASS – 3 POINTS





KNEE ON BELLY – 2 POINTS





MOUNT – 4 POINTS





BACK CONTROL – 4 POINTS



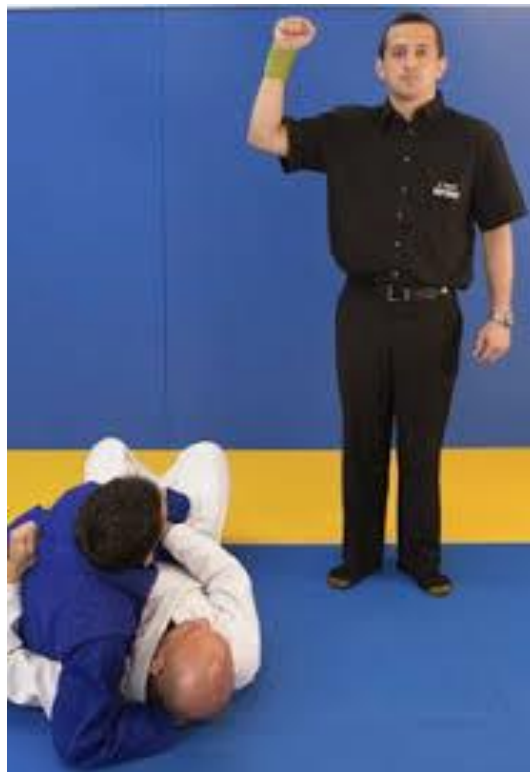


SWEEP – 2 POINTS
